

# Babyphant

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## **Materials:**

*When using the suggested materials, it will be about 12 cm tall.*

*The listed wool and hook sizes are only suggestions. It is, of course, entirely your personal choice, which yarn you use.*

*Please keep in mind that different yarn may result in a bigger or smaller piece. Make sure to adapt your hook size according to your yarn and personal tension.*

- Wool sport weight, fluffy yarn (grey) or any other grey yarn (can be brushed with a wire grooming brush for pets), some pink yarn (same weight), white thread
- Crochet hook in suitable size (for me: 2.5 mm)
- Stuffing
- Eyes in suitable size (for me: 10 mm)

## **Abbreviations (US Terms):**

MR = magic ring

inc = increase

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease

ch = chain

BLO = back loop only

slst = slip stitch

FLO = front loop only

st = stitch

(-) x = repeat inside of ( ) for x nr of times

*Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.*

*I hope, it's understandable and I'm really sorry if something sounds weird. 😊*

*To make the yarn fluffy just (even if you use a special fluff wool) brush it with a wire grooming brush for pets. You can use nearly each wool to brush.*

## **Head:**

*Grey*

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (9)
- 3.-7. (5 Rounds) inc, sc 3, dec, sc 3 (9)
8. sc in each st around (9)
9. sc 2, inc, sc 4, inc, sc 1 (11)
10. inc, sc 10 (12)
11. (sc 3, inc) x3 (15)
12. sc 7, inc x3, sc 5 (18)
13. sc 8, inc x6, sc 4 (24)
14. sc in each st around (24)
15. sc 7, (sc 1, inc) x6, sc 5 (30)
- 16.-23. (8 Rounds) sc in each st around (30)

*Stuff and shape the trunk.*

24. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)

25. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)

26. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

*Stuff and shape the head.*

27. dec x6 (6)

*Fasten off invisibly.*

*Attach the eyes. For the eyeball You can embroider a stitch with white yarn very close to the eye. Maybe use some glue to fix it.*

*Of course, You can crochet Your eyes. To do that make 6 sc in a magic ring, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew these eyes to the head and if You want embroider with white yarn some reflections to the eyes.*

## **Mouth:**

*Grey*

*Crochet in rows. At the end of each row, chain 1 and turn.*

1. sc 6 in MR (6) < - Don't close the magic ring, just tighten it.
2. inc x6 (12)

*Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

*Sew the mouth in a suitable place under the trunk.*

## **Ear (make 4):**

*Make 2 grey ears and 2 pink ears.*

*First crochet the pink ears.*

1. sc 4 in MR (4) < - Don't close the magic ring, just tighten it.
2. inc x4 (8)
3. (sc 1, inc) x4 (12)
4. (sc 2, inc) x4 (16)

*Fasten off invisibly the pink ears.*

*Now crochet a grey one and don't fasten off. Place both pieces with the pretty side facing outwards, insert hook into a pink stitch, pull the grey loop through and crochet the two pieces together with sc 16.*

*Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.*

*Your first ear is ready now. Repeat for the second Ear.*

## **Body:**

*Grey*

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
- 7.-14. (8 Rounds) sc in each st around (36)
15. sc 9, (sc 4, dec) x3, sc 9 (33)
16. sc in each st around (33)
17. sc 8, (sc 4, dec) x3, sc 7 (30)
18. sc in each st around (30)
19. sc 6, (sc 4, dec) x3, sc 6 (27)
20. (sc 7, dec) x3 (24)
21. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
22. sc in each st around (18)

*Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

*Stuff and shape the body and sew the head to the body (preferably with mattress stitch).*

## **Leg (make 2):**

*Pink*

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
  2. inc x6 (12)
- Color change to grey.*
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
  4. **BLO:** sc in each st around (18)
  - 5.-10. (6 Rounds) sc in each st around (18)

*Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

*Embroider toes, stuff the leg and pin it to the body.*

## **Arm (make 2):**

*Pink*

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
  2. inc x6 (12)
- Color change to grey.*
- 3.-12. (10 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)

*Stuff the lower part (about half), flatten the arm and crochet together with sc.*

*Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

*Pin the arms to and if all looks good for you, sew arms and legs to the body.*

**Tail:**

*Grey*

1. ch 9, skip 1 ch, sc 8 along the chain (8)

*Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing. Knot some wool threads at the end.*

*That's it, your Babyphant is ready :o)*
