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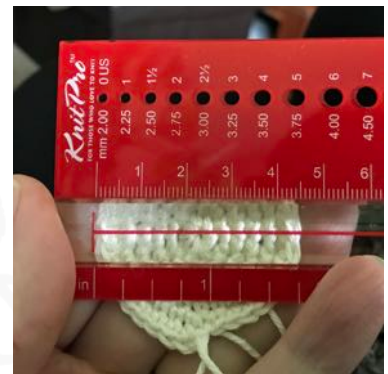


Materialliste:

- every yarn is suitable
- matching hook
- needle
- eyes
- black yarn for the face
- stuffing

Abbreviations (US Terms):

MR = magic ring
sc = single crochet
ch = chain
st = stitch
slst = slip stitch
inc = increase
dec = decrease
BLO = back loop only
FLO = front loop only



The specifications of the wool and needle sizes are only examples/references. If You use other wool than specified, the figure will become taller or smaller. It's Your choice which wool you use. The needle size must be chosen to match the wool used. When crocheting Amigurumis You should use a much smaller needle size than indicated on the band or You would use it for other crochet projects so that no holes are made when the piece is stuffed. With a needle size of 2 mm, my gauge sample results in a diameter of 4.5 cm for six crocheted rounds.

You are working in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.

I hope, it's understandable and I'm really sorry if something sounds weird. 😊

Head:

1. 6 sc in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (sc 5, inc) x6 (42)
8. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)
9. (sc 7, inc) x6 (54)
- 10.-14. (5 rounds) sc in each stitch (54)

If you use safety eyes, attach them between round 10 and 11.

15. (sc 7, dec) x6 (48)
16. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
17. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
18. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
19. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
20. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)

Stuff the head.

21. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)
22. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off, weaving in ends.

Body:

1. 6 sc in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
- 7.-10. (4 rounds) sc in each stitch (36)
11. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
12. sc in each stitch (30)
13. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
14. sc in each stitch (24)
15. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
16. sc in each stitch (18)
17. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)
18. sc in each stitch (12)

Fasten off but don't close, leave a long tail for sewing.

Stuff the body.

Nose:

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. (sc 1, inc) x3 (9)
- 3.-5. (3 rounds) sc in each stitch (9)

Stuff the nose.

6. (sc 1, dec) x3 (6)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Ear (2x):

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. sc in each stitch (12)
4. (sc 2, dec) x3 (9)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Leg (2x):

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
- 4.-6. (3 rounds) sc in each stitch (18)
7. (sc 1, dec) x3, sc 9 (15)
8. dec x3, sc 9 (12)

Stuff the foot.

9. (sc 2, dec) x3 (9)
- 10.-11. (2 rounds) sc in each stitch (9)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Don't stuff the leg, flatten the top and sew it together.



Arm (2x):

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
- 3.-5. (3 rounds) sc in each stitch (12)

Stuff the hand.

6. (sc 2, dec) x3 (9)
- 7.-13. (7 rounds) sc in each stitch (9)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Don't stuff the arm, flatten the top and sew it together.



Finishing:



Pin every piece at the place where it has to be.

Sew all pieces (nose, ears, arms and legs), If not

already done, attach the eyes between round 10 and 11. Embroider face. If you want you can attach on top of the head some threads as hair.
